The quite promising Erasmus+ KA220 project FUTURE ("Entrepreneurship's FUTURE is green and digital", code: 2022-2-PT02-KA220-YOU-000098632), which was launched on June 1, 2023, with the goal of sharing best practices in the field of young entrepreneurship, continues to be successfully implemented during the months following the initial work. The project aims to provide educational resources to target the development of digital and green skills applied to (social) entrepreneurship, in order to prepare future generations of entrepreneurs to provide innovative solutions to the existing demands in the society, and contribute to reducing youth unemployment.

The project consortium consists of ASEID Asociación para el Empleo, la Inclusión y el Desarrollo (Portugal - coordinator), Asociatia TEAM 4 Excellence (Romania), E-School Educational Group (Greece), and Efektas Group ((Lithuania).

Its target groups are: i) Youth Associations which provide training, coaching, and job counselling to youth, especially NEETs, ii) Youth workers, trainers, facilitators, coaches, or any other actor involved in the training and counselling of youth, focusing on the developing of green and digital skills, and iii) Youth, especially NEETs, interested in entrepreneurship.



On the 3rd of April 2024, the second transnational meeting successfully held in Constanza, Romania, in which, in a warm, professional cooperative and atmosphere, the partners assessed the project's progress to date and planned the next tasks and activities based on the Project Application and how best to meet the project's objectives.














Project Results

As far as the material production is concerned, the e-book version of the material containing the 10 modules corresponding to a specific area of competence of EnreComp, DigComp, and GreenComp, along with handy presentations of the modules content, quizzes aimed at the assessment of the learning material by the learners, and proposed activities on the corresponding areas, is completed.



The material produced has been translated in all partners' languages, in order to be better accessed by the target groups. Furthermore, the Moodle platform for material sharing and interactive learning, and the project website have also been developed, and the English version of the e-book, along with the publications so far have been uploaded.





The LTTA in Braga, which has been planned for the beginning of September 2024, is on the way, with the host and the partners organizing the participation details and the implementation of the activities each partner has planned.
